



October 29, 2010 (COW 1376 - Credit Card Fraud/CVS)

This week, the Chesterfield County/Colonial Heights Crime Solvers program needs help to identify two men who used a stolen credit card.

A clerk for the CVS store at 10100 Robious Road contacted police after a male suspect attempted to use a credit card to purchase a prepaid VISA gift card. The clerk noticed that the personal information on the card did not match the suspect presenting the card, and the transaction was declined. Unfortunately, a different store accepted the card in the purchase of two VISA gift cards.

The suspects were black males in their 20s. The one who presented the stolen card was approximately 6 feet tall, 180 pounds, wearing a black shirt, khaki shorts and a dark Colorado Rockies ball cap. The second male was approximately 6 feet, 5 inches tall, 230 pounds, and wore a light-green shirt and yellow wristband.



Oct. 22, 2010 (COW 1375 - Sept. 24 Shooting)

The Chesterfield County/Colonial Heights Crime Solvers program needs your help to identify and find two men who shot a man while attempting to rob him on Friday, Sept. 24, at about 11:20 p.m.

The suspects approached two men at gunpoint in the 6300 block of Jefferson Davis Highway and attempted to rob them of their cash. During the robbery, a single shot was fired at one of the males. The victim sustained a non-life-threatening gunshot wound. The suspects fled the area on foot toward Jefferson Davis Highway, and are described as black males in their 20s, wearing all black clothing.



October 15, 2010 (COW 1374 - Walmart Shoplifting)

Case Closed This week, the Chesterfield County/Colonial Heights Crime Solvers program needs help to identify a man who stole video game cartridges from a Walmart in Chesterfield County.



Between 8 and 9 p.m. on Saturday, Sept. 25, a man entered the Walmart at 14501 Hancock Village Street and went to the electronics department carrying a hand basket. He loaded X-Box and Playstation game cartridges into the basket and proceeded to the lawn and garden section of the store. After being confronted by an employee, the suspect set the basket down in the store, only to return to it minutes later. He grabbed the basket and fled using the fire-exit doors. He was seen running across the parking lot toward the Johnny Rockets restaurant. It was estimated that he got away with several-hundred dollars worth of game cartridges.



The suspect was described as a black male in his 20s, dark complexion, 5 feet, 9 inches tall and 160 pounds. He wore an orange T-shirt and a black do-rag on his head.



October 8, 2010 (COW 1373 - Robberies in Chesterfield)

The Chesterfield County/Colonial Heights Crime Solvers program needs your help to identify and find three men who used credit cards taken from robbery victims on Monday, Sept. 13, and Tuesday, Sept. 14 in Chesterfield County.

The suspects used the credit cards throughout the Richmond area to make purchases shortly after the robberies occurred. The suspects are described as a white male and two black males.



October 1, 2010 (COW 1372 - Robbery/Colonial Heights Walmart)

The Chesterfield County/Colonial Heights Crime Solvers program needs help to identify a man who robbed two Walmart employees in Colonial Heights.



During the late-night hours of Tuesday, Aug. 10, a black male entered the Walmart at 671 Southpark Blvd. and approached two employees in the Tire and Lube section of the store. The suspect gestured as if he had a gun, demanded they hand over their two-way radios and cell phones, then proceeded to take the store's cash. He left the area in a red, newer-model Chevrolet pickup, striking a shopping cart on the truck's passenger side.
