

**November 26, 2010 (COW 1380 –  
Motorcycle Hit & Run)**

The Chesterfield County/Colonial Heights Crime Solvers program needs your help to solve an unusual hit-and-run case that occurred on Tuesday, Sept. 14.



At approximately 2:30 p.m., a man was riding a motorcycle north on Harrowgate Road and pulled into the lane to turn right onto Route 10, also known as Iron Bridge Road. While traveling in the turn lane, a tan-colored van abruptly pulled into the same turn lane forcing the motorcyclist to firmly apply his brakes. The cyclist pulled beside the van and verbally confronted the driver. The driver of the van argued back, then used the corner of his van to push over the motorcyclist before driving away east on Route 10.

The driver of the van was described as a black male with gray or partially gray hair.

**November 19, 2010 (COW 1379 – James  
Mart Robbery)**



The Chesterfield County/Colonial Heights Crime Solvers program needs your help to identify and find a man who robbed the James Mart at 14103 Harrowgate Road on Saturday, Sept. 4, at about 9:30 p.m.

The suspect approached an employee, demanded money at gunpoint and then fled on foot in an unknown direction. The suspect is described as a black male, wearing dark clothing with a camouflaged styled hunting mask. The suspect also wore a dark-colored hat with a “Y” on it and was also seen carrying a black and red backpack.



### **November 12, 2010 (COW 1378 – Identity Theft & ID Fraud)**

This week, the Chesterfield County/Colonial Heights Crime Solvers program needs help to identify a woman who used counterfeit checks and stolen identities.



A woman presented checks to three different banks in Chesterfield County, all written to the last name of Massie. One bank clerk recognized the account and knew the account holder personally. She contacted the account holder and discovered that the checks were fraudulent. Before the account was closed, thousands of dollars worth of checks had been cashed. Investigators located the Massie subject, whose identification was presented during the transactions, and realized that she and a second woman were victims of identity theft.

The suspect was a black female, approximately 5 feet, 5 inches tall, 170 pounds, with a dark complexion and long braided hair.

**November 5, 2010 (COW 1377 – Two Robberies off of Route 1)**



The Chesterfield County/Colonial Heights Crime Solvers program needs your help to identify and find a suspect who committed two robberies in the area of Jefferson Davis Highway, and one robbery in the area of Turner Road and Walmsley Blvd. In all three robberies, a black male entered the store and immediately covered his face with his shirt, approached the clerk, displayed a handgun, and robbed the store of cash.

The first robbery occurred at Miller Mart on Turner Road on Monday, May 10 at about 11:30 p.m. The second robbery occurred at Miller Mart on Jefferson Davis Highway on Thursday, August 12 at about 8:30 a.m. The third robbery occurred at Market Place on Jefferson Davis Highway on Friday, August 27 at about 9 p.m.
