

## **February 25, 2011 (COW 1393 - Abduction/Robbery)**



The Chesterfield County/Colonial Heights Crime Solvers program needs your help to identify and catch a group of Hispanic males who committed two robberies in the area of Jefferson Davis Highway. In both of the robberies, the victims were placed in a vehicle by force, abducted, assaulted and robbed of cash.

The first robbery, during which the victim was assaulted and held at gunpoint, occurred on Friday, Dec. 3, at about 10:30 p.m. The victim in this case was abducted from the Salvadoneno restaurant. During the second robbery, which occurred on Saturday, Dec. 4, at about 1:45 a.m., the victim was assaulted and held at knifepoint. The victim in this case was abducted from the area of the El Tequila.

In both robberies, a dark colored Ford Explorer or Expedition with dark tinted windows was used.

## **February 18, 2011 (COW 1392 - Credit Card Fraud / Copper Avalanche)**



Surveillance footage has yielded yet another suspect in a credit-card fraud case. Crime Solvers needs your help identifying the suspect.

A Chesterfield County resident paid off her credit card in June 2010 and since then did not use the card. In November 2010, the victim received a statement showing 19 charges that occurred between Oct. 3 and Oct. 29, 2010, that the victim did not authorize.

The card was used four times at the WaWa located at 3199 South Crater Road in Petersburg and seven times at the WaWa located at 11701 Jefferson Davis Highway in Chester. Surveillance footage pointed to a copper-colored Chevrolet Avalanche. On two of the occasions, the truck was pulling a solid-white enclosed trailer.



### **February 11, 2011 (COW 1391 - Homicide)**

The Chesterfield County/Colonial Heights Crime Solvers program needs your help to identify and find the people responsible for shooting and killing a man in the 3900 block of Bridget Court on Friday, Nov. 12, 2010, at about 11:40 p.m.

Officers were initially called for shots being fired in the area. The officers found the victim while checking the area. The victim, James Patrick Mosley was shot several times in the parking lot of his town house. Officers and rescue personnel attempted to resuscitate Mosley but were unsuccessful. Witnesses described seeing a black male wearing a dark-colored hooded sweatshirt in the area at the time of the shooting. A dark-colored vehicle was also seen leaving the area at a high rate of speed shortly after the shooting.

### **February 4, 2011 (COW 1390 - Home Invasion)**

A frightening incident occurred for two area children, and the Chesterfield County/Colonial Heights Crime Solvers program needs your help to identify and locate the suspect.



Just prior to 2 p.m. on Tuesday, Jan. 11, a man knocked on the door of a townhome on Natick Court in the Sturbridge Village Townhouses of Chesterfield County. When a 12-year-old child opened the door to answer it, the male forced his way into the townhome, tied up the young boy and his 10-year-old sister, and then stole televisions and gaming systems from the residence. The suspect left the scene, and other than the initial binding, the children were not injured.

The suspect was described as a black male, 30-49 years old, 5 feet 7 inches tall, thin build, with a mustache and goatee. He wore a black, satin, puffy-style coat and a black ball cap over a black do-rag. The suspect indicated that there was a second person outside, but no other suspect was seen.
