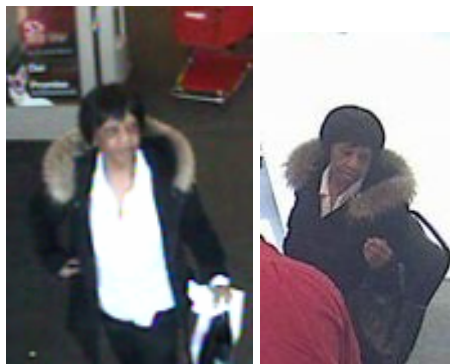


March 25, 2011 (COW 1397 - Credit Card Fraud)



The Chesterfield County/Colonial Heights Crime Solvers program needs your help to solve a theft in which credit cards were stolen from a victim on Friday, Feb. 25, 2011.

The suspect managed to steal the victim's credit cards, and then used the stolen credit cards to make fraudulent purchases throughout Chesterfield. Several thousand dollars in purchases were made to the victim's cards. The suspect was photographed by security cameras making a transaction at the HH Gregg located at 1321 Huguenot Road. Fraudulent purchases were also made at the Best Buy, and Outback Steakhouse near Huguenot Road. The suspect appears to be a middle-aged black female.

March 18, 2011 (COW 1396 - Premier Audio Break-in)



An electronics store in Chesterfield County was broken into, and the Chesterfield County/Colonial Heights Crime Solvers program needs your help to identify the suspects.

Between midnight and 1:30 a.m. on Wednesday, Feb. 16, three suspects worked together to break into and steal electronics from Premier Audio, located at 7112 Hull Street Road. The suspects used a rock to break through the front glass door, and, once inside, stole items such as automobile television monitors, Thunder brand speakers, Pioneer amplifiers and a Dell laptop computer.

Video surveillance in the store recorded the incident. The three suspects were black males. All appeared to be between 18 and 25 years old, and they all wore dark clothing.



March 11, 2011 (COW 1395 - Shooting/Robbery Attempt)

The Chesterfield County/Colonial Heights Crime Solvers program needs your help to identify and find a man who shot at and attempted to rob two victims in the 3100 block of Tanners Way on Saturday, Dec. 4, 2010 at about 8:20 p.m.



The suspect approached the two victims, demanded money at gunpoint and then fired a single gunshot round in the air. The suspect later pointed his weapon at the victims and fired several rounds, striking one of the victims once. After being shot, the victim fought with the suspect, but the suspect was able to get away and avoid capture. The witnesses described the suspect as a black male with a medium complexion and a goatee, 5 feet, 6 inches tall, thin or slender build and in his early 20s.



March 4, 2011 (COW 1394 - Prescription Fraud)

Case Closed The Chesterfield County/Colonial Heights Crime Solvers program needs your help to locate a suspect who passed forged prescriptions.



A white male approached the pharmacists of the Rite Aid and CVS drug stores on Weir Place in Chesterfield and presented fraudulent prescriptions for Oxycodone. The suspect was seen getting into a dark blue Ford Explorer. Investigators have a person of interest in the case. Douglas Adam Dabney, known as “adam”, is currently wanted by Colonial Heights Police Department on several similar felony charges.
