

## **April 29, 2011 (Crime of the Week 1402 - Vending Machine Thefts)**

**Case Closed** Crime Solvers needs your help to solve a string of thefts from coin-operated machines.



Between April 11 and April 22, Chesterfield Police officers documented 11 incidents throughout the county in which coin-operated vending machines were broken into. In each case, the coin and bill collection slots were pried open. Money was obtained from some of the machines, but not all of them.

Two of the most recent thefts occurred on Friday, April 22, at the Sleep Inn, 6451 Bayside Lane, and the Holiday Inn Express, 5030 West Village Green Drive. Surveillance footage from the Holiday Inn Express captured images of a suspect. He is a white male who appears to be in his late 20s or early 30s. He has a heavy or stocky build and a small mustache. He wore a black jacket with a thin stripe down each sleeve, gray pants and a dark ball cap. He was carrying a large, dark backpack on his shoulders. He left the area on a motorcycle.

## **April 22, 2011 (COW 1401 - Credit Card Theft)**

**Case Closed** The Chesterfield County/Colonial Heights Crime Solvers program needs your help to solve a credit card theft case in which withdrawals were made fraudulently to a victims account on Saturday, Feb. 19.



The suspect managed to withdraw several hundreds of dollars from the victim's account on four separate occasions. The suspect in the case used the victim's credit card to complete this crime. The transactions occurred at the Bank of America located at 10700 Midlothian Turnpike. The suspect was photographed by security cameras while making the transactions, and was seen in a grey or black SUV.

## **April 15, 2011 (COW 1400 - Debit card theft from Uno's)**



The Chesterfield County/Colonial Heights Crime Solvers program needs your help to identify a woman involved in a debit card fraud.

On Feb. 14, the victim was dining at the Uno's restaurant in Prince George and left her purse in her car. While she was in the restaurant, someone stole her purse. At approximately 8:17 p.m., someone used her card to withdraw cash from the ATM at Virginia Credit Union on Temple Lake Drive in Colonial Heights.

Video surveillance attached to the ATM recorded images of a female suspect using the card. She is a black female, and she wore a heavy coat with a fur-lined hood and eyeglasses.



## **April 8, 2011 (COW 1399 - Identity Theft)**

The Chesterfield County/Colonial Heights Crime Solvers program needs your help to solve an identity theft case in which withdrawals were made fraudulently to a victims account on Friday, March 18, 2011.

The suspect managed to withdraw several thousands of dollars from the victims account on three separate occasions. The suspect in the case is presenting false documentation, assuming the identity of the victim in this crime. One of the transactions occurred at the Bank of America located at 2601 Buford Road, and two other transactions occurred at Bank of America branches in Henrico County. The suspect was photographed by security cameras while making the transactions. The suspect appears to be a middle-aged male and may be Caucasian or Hispanic.



### **April 1, 2011 (COW 1398 - Stolen Loaders)**

The Chesterfield County/Colonial Heights Crime Solvers program is lending its resources to help recover two pieces of stolen construction equipment and identify the suspects involved.

During the overnight hours between March 14 and March 15, someone stole a yellow John Deere 325 Skid Steer Loader from a construction site at 10230 Iron Bridge Road. This is the future site of a Walgreens pharmacy, not far from the Chesterfield County Courthouse.



A second wheeled loader was stolen along the Iron Bridge corridor approximately 10 days earlier. In that incident, a Bobcat S185 Skid-Steer Loader was stolen from a residential construction site at 6500 Caymus Way in the Meridian Watermark Apartments.
