Dear Friends and Supporters of Crime Solvers:

The Chesterfield County/Colonial Heights Crime Solvers **19th Annual Fundraising Golf Tournament** will be held on Thursday, April 26, 2012, at the **Country Club at the Highlands**, 8136 Highland Glen Drive in Chesterfield, Virginia. We are holding this tournament in partnership with our Major Sponsor, **Mercedes-Benz of Midlothian**. This notice is being sent early to allow ample time for any potential sponsors and players to register, select sponsorship levels and mark their calendars for this event.

The annual golf tournament is Crime Solvers' primary fundraising event. Using responsible stewardship, proceeds from the tournament are used to pay rewards to tipsters when law enforcement cases are resolved and fugitives are arrested due to our program, and are also used to support our scholastic clubs in Chesterfield and Colonial Heights. Due to the anonymity aspect of our program, reward funding is entirely derived from donations from the public and local businesses. **Again, NO government funds are used to pay rewards generated by successful tips.**

About the Tournament:

We encourage you to plan for a FULL day at our tournament! We will open registration at 8:30 A.M. with a **McDonald's** breakfast and a "goodie bag" for each player. A shotgun start will occur at **10 A.M.** with Captain's Choice rules in effect for play. *Seniors 65 and older will play from the designated Senior Tees, and ladies will play from the designated Ladies Tees.* A box lunch will be provided by **Sheetz**, and at the end of the golfing day, a dinner will be provided by **Ledo Pizza**. Beverages will be provided throughout the day. Place-team, field contest and other door prizes will be awarded during the dinner...and all of this (food, beverages and prizes) is included as part of the player/team registration fee. The cost to enter a 4-person team into the tournament will be **\$400**. One 4-man team registration is included with each Eagle-level sponsorship. Singles can enter the tournament for a fee of **\$100** and will be paired with other players to create full teams.
